Important Reminder: Your PTA/PTSA financial review is due July 15th at the Kentucky PTA office to remain in good standing.

Review forms should be signed by 3 people (or 1 CPA) who is not currently a check signer on the account, or related to a check signer on the account. This is the time a committee reviews the books. The treasurer and president should help the committee and answer any questions, but cannot sign the financial review form.

Call to the 2019 Kentucky PTA Convention

The Kentucky PTA Congress of Parents and Teachers, Inc., hereby calls upon its membership to send duly accredited delegates to the Convention to be held on July 19 & 20, 2019 at Tates Creek Middle School in Lexington, Kentucky.

Kentucky PTA Bylaws, Article XVI: Kentucky PTA Annual Convention

Section 1.

e. Each local PTA/PTSA in good standing as shown on the records in the Kentucky PTA Office thirty (30) days before the Kentucky PTA Annual Convention, shall be entitled to be represented at the Annual Convention of the Kentucky PTA by its president, or alternate, and one (1) accredited delegate plus one (1) additional delegate for every twenty-five (25) members, or a major fraction thereof.

#f. A local unit PTA/PTSA in good standing is one which:

1. Adheres to the Purposes and basic policies of PTA.
2. Remits the National and Kentucky portions of dues to Kentucky PTA as required;
3. Remits District portion of the dues as required;
4. Reviews the treasurer's books and submits the PTA Financial Review Form (formally the audit report form) to the Kentucky PTA Office by July 15;
5. Files with the IRS the proper Federal 990EZ or 990N (e-postcard) and sends a copy to the Kentucky PTA Office by November 15th;
6. Has bylaws approved by the Kentucky PTA every five (5) years;
7. Has an IRS Employer Identification Number (EIN) on file in the Kentucky PTA state office; and

8. Maintains a minimum of ten (10) members.



You can file your taxes

Did you know you can file your 990 at anytime after July 1st. As soon as your financial review is completed? This will save you from trying to remember to do them in November.

You must file your 990 by November 15th If your PTA had under \$50,000 you can file your taxes with just a few clicks by using the file990 service that Kentucky PTA provides for each local unit. [File 990 Website](#)
